Along with the excellent selection of cabins that you'll find across our fleet, guests on *Balmoral* can opt for one of our newly refurbished Ocean View cabins.






OUR SUITE DREAMS PACKAGE







Sailing through the Chilean Fjords will present you with glaciers and snow-capped peaks, and the chance to spot Magellanic penguins, while in Australia you'll find iconic koalas and kangaroos. You can also seek out marine life among the azure waters and coral reefs of Bora Bora. Our highlight tours in Ggeberha, South Africa, mean you can head off in search of the coveted 'Big Five'. Elsewhere, you'll have the chance to visit the colossal Iguazu Falls in Argentina, and the oldest desert in the world, the Namib, in Africa • Throughout your journey, you can learn about the trading cultures of each destination and how they helped shape the regions we are visiting. Hear about the Gold Rush of the 1800s in Victoria, as well as unique Tahitian pearls, the country's largest export. There are also opportunities to visit the vineyards of South Africa, and Kolmanskop, a ghost town once rich in diamonds • A call to the Juan Fernández Islands brings alive the story of Alexander Selkirk, the Scottish sailor who inspired the novel Robinson Crusoe, while Tahiti and Tonga were once explored by Captain James Cook.
